The objective of a bull test is to measure the differences of a group of bulls; to observe and document average daily gain, genetic expression, phenotypic strengths, etc. Two of the primary purposes of Midland Bull Test is to focus on soundness and fertility. The fall out for fertility is relatively low in our test partially due to the ration fed. The high level of roughage coupled with the low level of grain promotes ultimate soundness in the feet and legs and also aids in attaining the highest levels of fertility. Our bulls walk through the sale in fit using condition ready to go to work. The importance of bulls being capable of maintaining their condition and working when turned out is critical to your success and ours. Every effort is made to offer functional bulls that transition into the life of a successful and fit asset to your operation. 

Sale Order – Determined by Midland Bull Test Index ($\frac{1}{4}$ ADG + $\frac{1}{4}$ NR + $\frac{1}{4}$ YR + $\frac{1}{4}$ ER efficiency ratio) and Estimated Sale Value. We do expect small changes in sale order. They will be posted online with current version on the bottom. Sale orders will be posted online prior to sale and available sale day. Sale day orders trump.

Terms Are Cash – When making settlement, please leave specific instructions for transfer and shipping. Each animal will be sold to the highest bidder with the auctioneer settling any dispute as to bids. Announcements made from the auction block take precedence over any printed material. Livestock will be cared for following the sale at the buyer's risk and responsibility.

Certificate of Registry – A transferred certificate of registry will be furnished to the Buyer for each animal after settlement has been made.

Health – All cattle will be sold according to the health regulations of the State of Montana. Buyers must be aware of any variations between the laws of the states. All bulls have tested BVD-PI negative and are tested negative for known genetic defects as detected by pedigree per respective Associations as of 2/28/15. Furthermore, bulls sold into states that require trich test will be trich tested after sale and trucking arrangements will be made in short order.

MIDLAND BULL TEST

Terms & Conditions – All sales are being conducted under the American Angus Association Suggested Sale Terms and Conditions (2/21/14) regardless of breed of sale bull.

At Midland, we equally value and appreciate our consignors and buyers; and we are cognizant of the risk incurred by both. With a commitment to mitigate and minimize risk for both parties, Midland has implemented a modified bull guarantee. All guarantees will be serviced through an independent insurance agency. Buyers who desire to guarantee bulls (insure), must initiate coverage at check-out following the sale. Midland Bull Test will cover 1/2 of the insurance premium for the first 6 months on any bull sold at the Midland Sales April 6-7. Coverage will include All Risk Mortality with Theft, Agreed Value, Guaranteed Renewal and an Infertility Endorsement. The cost to the buyer for 6 months is 3% of the purchase prices or 5% for annual (12 months) policy. Special consideration for bulls standing at a collection facility.

Canadian Buyers – Estimated health inspection costs for first bull purchase is \$500. Each additional bull is \$125 per bull. Midland will split this cost equally with buyer for health inspection and testing.

Fertility Tested & Guaranteed – Complete semen and scrotal evaluations on all bulls are performed by Bryan Roe, DVM, Shepherd, MT. **Scrotal measurements for group 1 (*) were taken mid-February. Group 2 (**) were taken the first week of March. All are published as actual size.** For projected sale date size, add 1 to 1.5 cm per month. These bulls sell guaranteed to be breeders via natural service.

Efficiency Test – Bulls are denoted as *(group 1) or *(group 2). RFI is given in this catalog. Complete efficiency test results are available at www.MidlandBullTest.com.

1/3 Revenue Sharing Semen Interest – Some breeders have elected to retain semen interest in their bulls. The buyer will have full possession and full salvage value. The seller, if he/she desires to collect semen, will do so in the off-breeding season at the seller's expense and the buyer's convenience. If the buyer opts to participate in semen sales, then buyer and seller will work out a mutual agreement. Over the years it has been Midland's experience that most sellers do not exercise this option on bulls going into commercial herds.

Delivery – Cattle purchased in our sale will be delivered to CENTRAL locations, such as stockyards, in the lower 48 states Please see page 9 for our delivery policy, map and costs.

Everyone attending the sale does so at their own risk. The owners and Midland assume no liability, legal or otherwise, for any accidents which may occur.

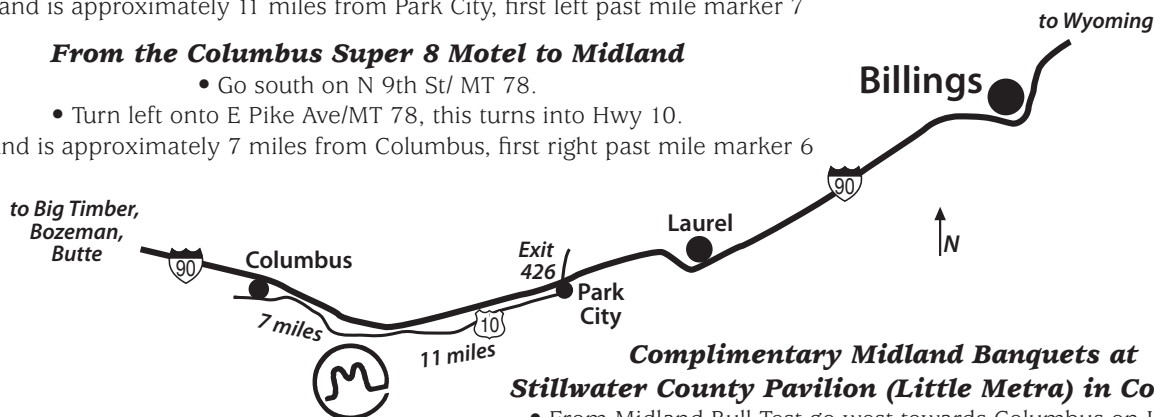

Measuring RFI (Residual Feed Index) is a measure of feed intake for maintenance and productivity. RFI is a calculation of true feed utilization, with a negative number (-1.5 lbs/day) being more efficient than a positive number (+1.5 lbs/day) when balanced with production, i.e. gain. ☺

Feed efficiency EPDs attempt to capture an animal's genetic ability to put on more weight with less feed. While there are many ways to calculate feed efficiency (such as feed conversion ratio and residual average daily gain), an especially useful way is residual feed intake or RFI. RFI is feed intake adjusted for an animal's weight and gain. An animal that eats more also tends to be larger and gain more weight. By adjusting these factors out of an animal's intake measurement, we are able to better understand which animals process feed more efficiently. We can then select for our typical growth traits (yearling weight, weaning weight, or post wean gain) and at the same time select for intake (in the form of RFI) and know that there is no double counting of an animal's size.

The RFI EPDs are expressed in actual kgs of feed an animal will eat per day. And like other EPDs, they have an associated accuracy that expresses how sure can be of the predicted performance. The table to the right has an example of three bulls with RFI EPDs. We would expect bull X's calves to eat 0.65 kg more feed per day than the average calf his size, bull Y's to eat 0.35 kg less feed per day than the average calf his size, and bull Z's to eat 0.42 kg less feed than the average calf his size. Based on these numbers, we would obviously rather chose bull Z as a sire.

Another consideration is the accuracy of prediction in selecting animals. While bull Z is more efficient than bull Y, his accuracy is also lower meaning we're less sure about his EPDs.

If we are in a situation when we would like more accuracy in our selection, we may select bull Y since his feed efficiency EPD is close to bull Z's but his accuracy is much higher.

Single trait selection is always a bad idea. RFI is no exception to this rule. Selection for RFI should always be done in conjunction with selection for growth. This selection for growth can be done by looking at weaning weight, yearling weight, or post wean gain EPDs. This will allow breeders to pick animals that gain the most while consuming the least amount of feed.

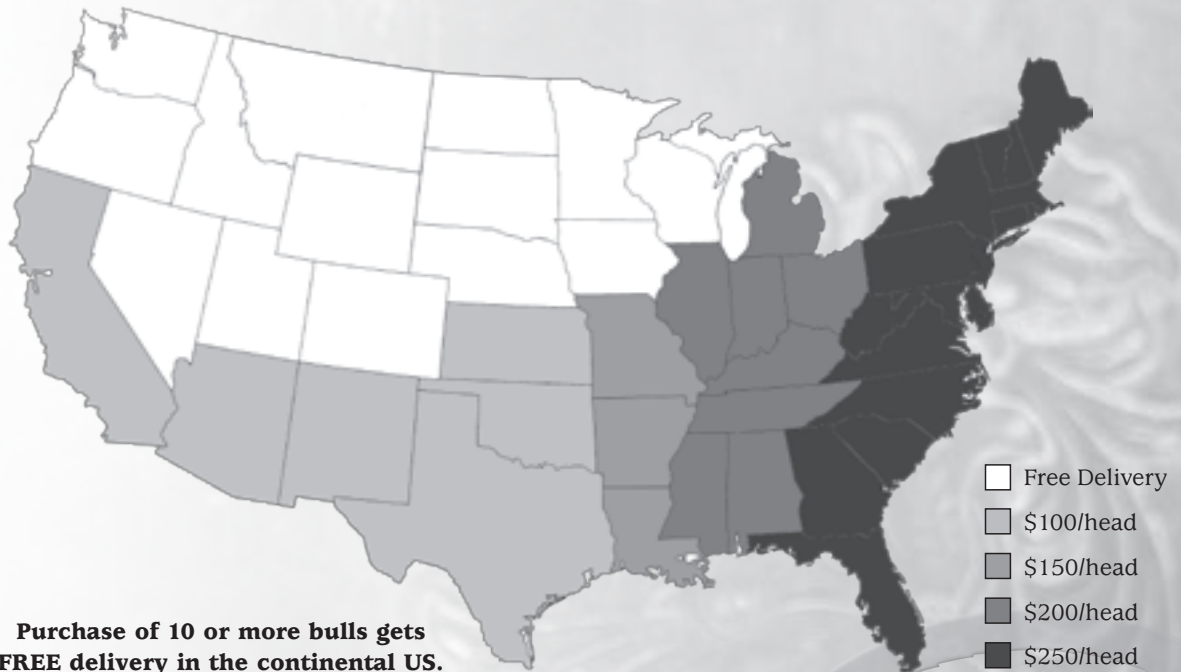

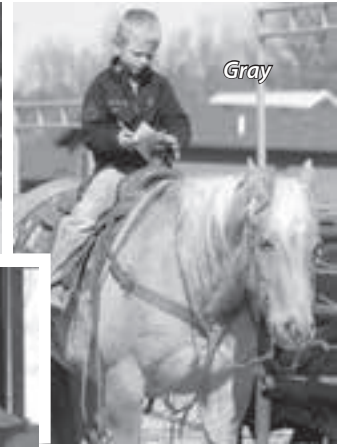

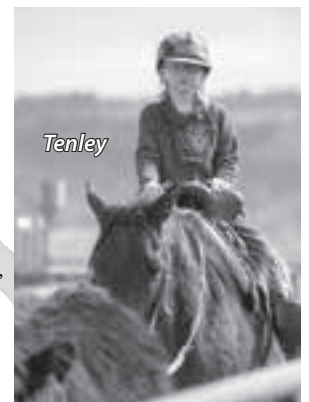

EPDs (Expected Progeny Difference)

CED/CE - Calving Ease Direct is expressed as a difference in percentage of unassisted births, with a higher value indicating greater calving ease in first calf heifers. It predicts the average difference in ease with which an sire's calves will be born when he is bred to first-calf heifers.
Scrotal/SC - Scrotal Circumference EPD, expressed in centimeters, is a predictor of the difference in transmitting ability for scrotal size compared to that of other sires.
TM/MWW/M&G - Total Maternal, Maternal Weaning Weight EPD measures a sire's ability to transmit milk production and growth rate through his daughters. It predicts the weaning weight of a sire's daughters' calves. It is equal to his Milk EPD plus one-half his weaning weight EPD.
CEM/MCE - Calving Ease Maternal is expressed as a difference in percentage of unassisted births with a higher value indicating greater calving ease in first-calf daughters. It predicts the average ease with which a sire's daughters will calve as first-calf heifers when compared to daughters of other sires.
Marbling - Intramuscular Fat EPD is a predictor of the difference in a sire's progeny for percent intramuscular fat in the ribeye muscle compared to other sires. (Angus, Red Angus and Simmental give ultrasound derived EPDs)
REA - Ribeye area EPD is a predictor of the difference in square inches of ribeye area of a sire's progeny compared to the progeny of other sires. (Angus, Red Angus and Simmental give ultrasound derived EPDs)
Fat - Fat thickness EPD, expressed in inches, is a predictor of the difference in external fat thickness at the 12th rib of a sire's progeny compared to the progeny of other sires. It includes the weighted average of 60% of the rib fat measurement and 40% of the rump fat measurement. (Angus, Red Angus and Simmental give ultrasound derived EPDs)
CW/CWT - Carcass Weight EPD, expressed in pounds, is a predictor of the differences in hot carcass weight of a sire's progeny compared to progeny of other sires.
\$B - Beef Value, an index value expressed in dollars per head, is the expected average difference in future progeny performance for postweaning and carcass value compared to progeny of other sires.
FPI - Feeder Profit Index, an economic selection index designed to aid producers in selecting sires whose progeny will perform in the feedlot and are sold on grade and yield. Well ranking sires for FPI have higher marbling and carcass weight than their contemporaries. As a terminal index, little emphasis is put on maternal traits such as stayability and calving ease.
