- 2. Acts will be allotted no more than **FIVE (5) minutes** to perform. There will be a five (5) point deduction if performance goes over allotted time.
- 3. Participants may only perform **ONE** time for their points to count, but may help another participant set up props, etc.
- 4. No profanity or vulgar lyrics in any vocal performance or dance music. This is a family oriented event.
- 5. No open flames or any other dangerous additions.
- 6. Microphone will be provided. Acts **MUST** provide their own recorded music, instruments, props, etc. Recorded music must be on a CD, flash drive, or ox cord for phone.
- 7. If participant needs music, please have it to the committee prior to event for sound check.

- Costuming and effective use of any props
- Accuracy and recovery from mistakes
- Choreography
- Effectiveness of opening and finale
- Total impact of a performance.
- Confidence
- Facial expressions and on-stage personality
