The winning state will receive a cash award and travelling golden pitchfork. Cash awards will also be presented to second and third place states.

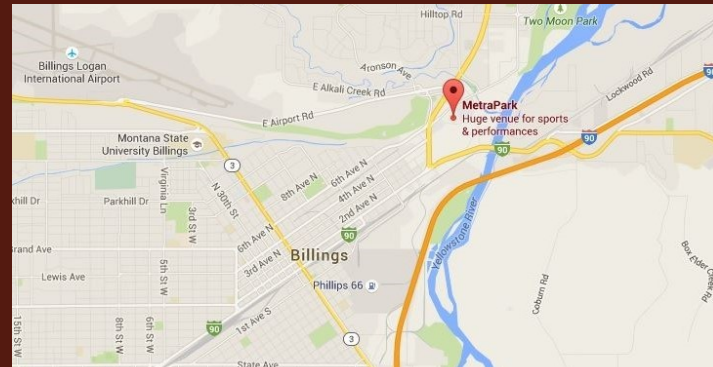

Original registration certificates or copies for each animal should be present at time of check-in. Entries must meet Montana Health Regulations.

Juniors must be members of the North American South Devon Junior Association. An application for membership can be filled out at registration if you are not a member and the \$15 lifetime membership fee can be paid at that time.

Entries are due June 8th. The late entry deadline is June 15th.

On-site registration is available, however you must pay the \$40 late entry fee.
